New General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) come into force on 25th May 2018. To comply with these regulations, we need your permission to collect and retain some of your data. We will also ask your permission to send you emails about other events of interest.

The privacy statement below gives basic details and we will be asking you to sign in person or by e mail to say that you accept these terms.

Your member data – what we need and why

We need some of your details, for example your name and email address, so that we can let you know about things like community matters.

What data do we collect from members?

We collect this data from members

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We check what data we have on members every two years and remove it if we no longer need it. If you leave the group, we'll make sure we stop using and delete any data

What do we use it for?

Any of the information listed above might be used to send you information. We won't ever use this data for anything else unless you give us your active consent for that additional use.

Do we share your data with anyone else?

- We will never give your data to third parties for that third party to use.

What can you ask us to do?

At any time you can ask to view, update or correct any data we hold on you. You can also ask that we stop using your data or that we erase it.
