- 3. Local police will continue to run a high visibility road safety campaign throughout February until early March to deter speeding and hopefully reduce collisions and the number of people injured or killed on our roads which has unfortunately seen a rise. The rise in drink drivers is a concern and the detection increase may be linked to the additional resources deployed to this road safety campaign.


